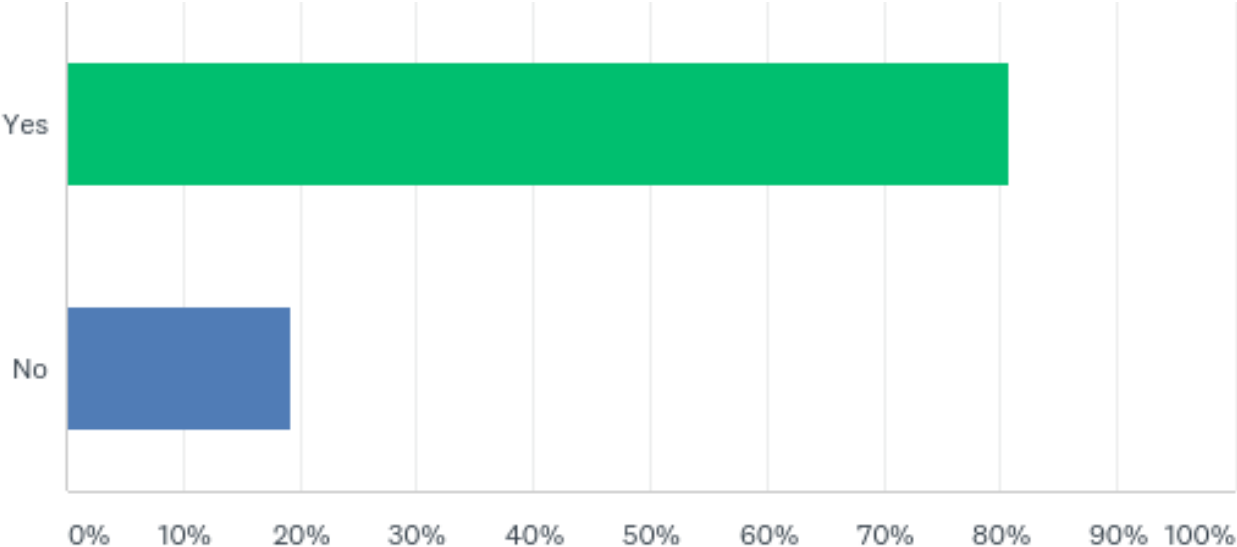

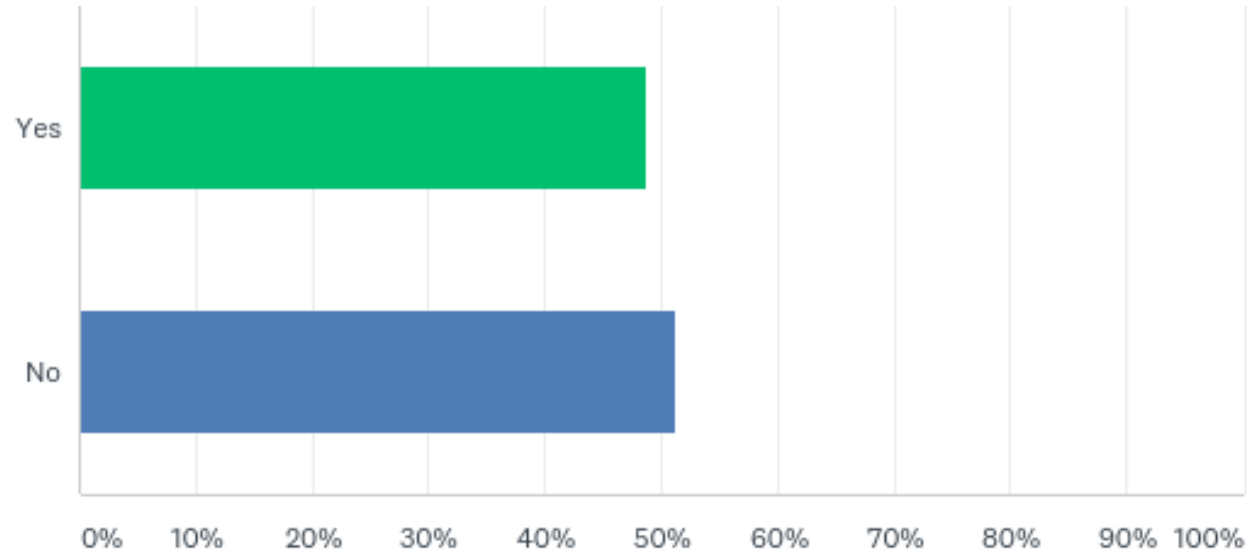

Q4: Would you expect your home boarder to be formally qualified in home boarding e.g. the same way a child minder is?

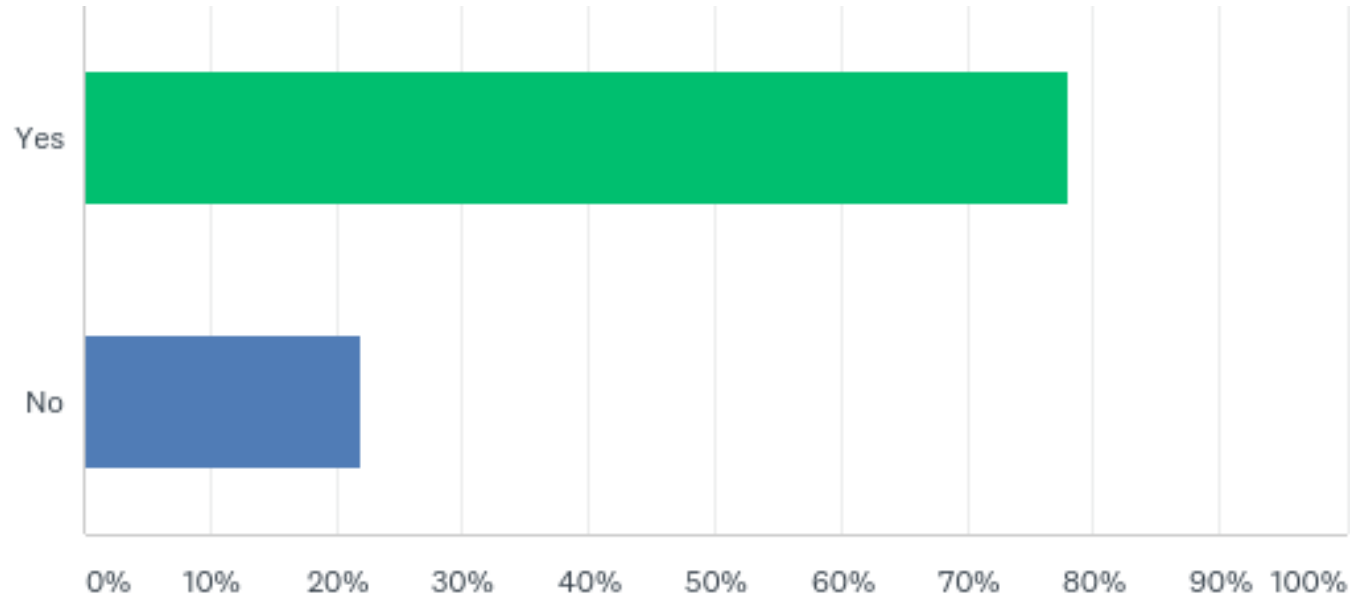

Q5: Would you expect your boarder to be Canine First Aid trained?

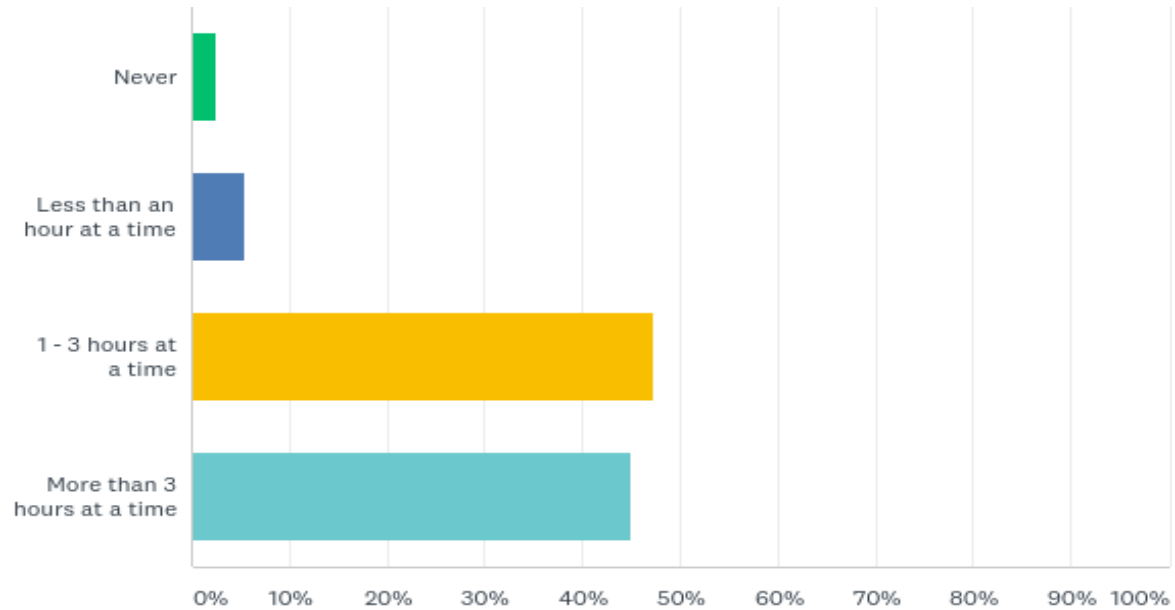

Q6: Do you ever leave your dog?

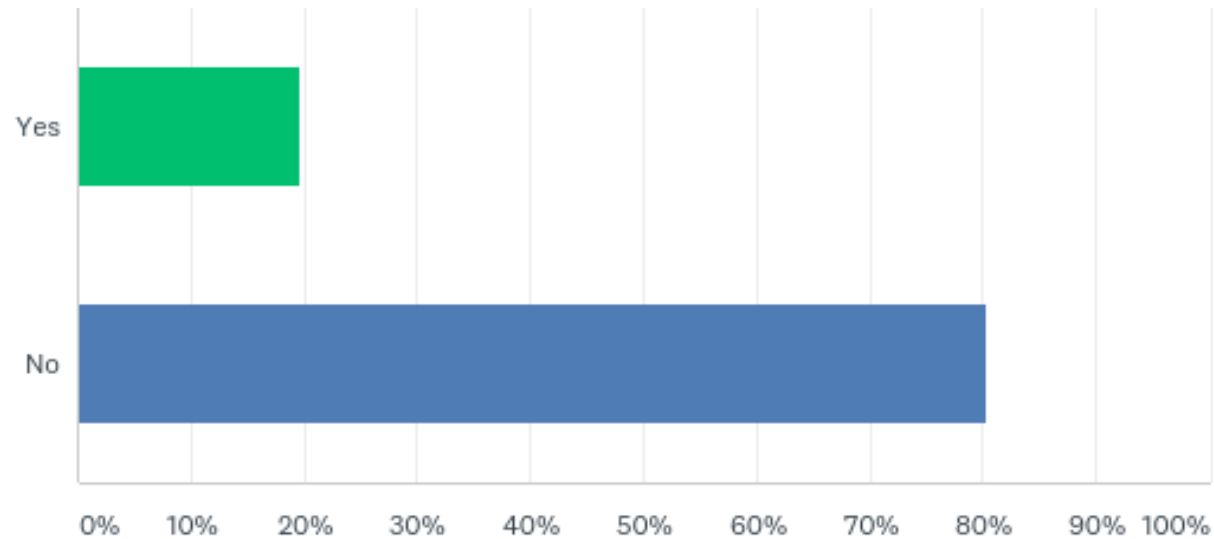

Q7: Do/would you expect your boarder to stay with the dogs all day for the time they are in their care?

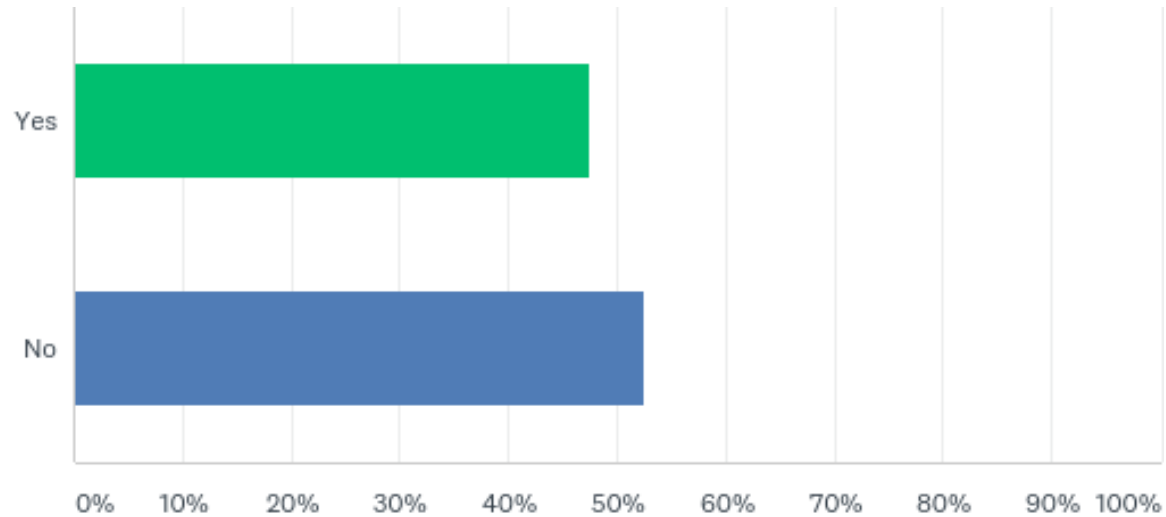

Q8: If the dogs were left would you expect them to be separated?

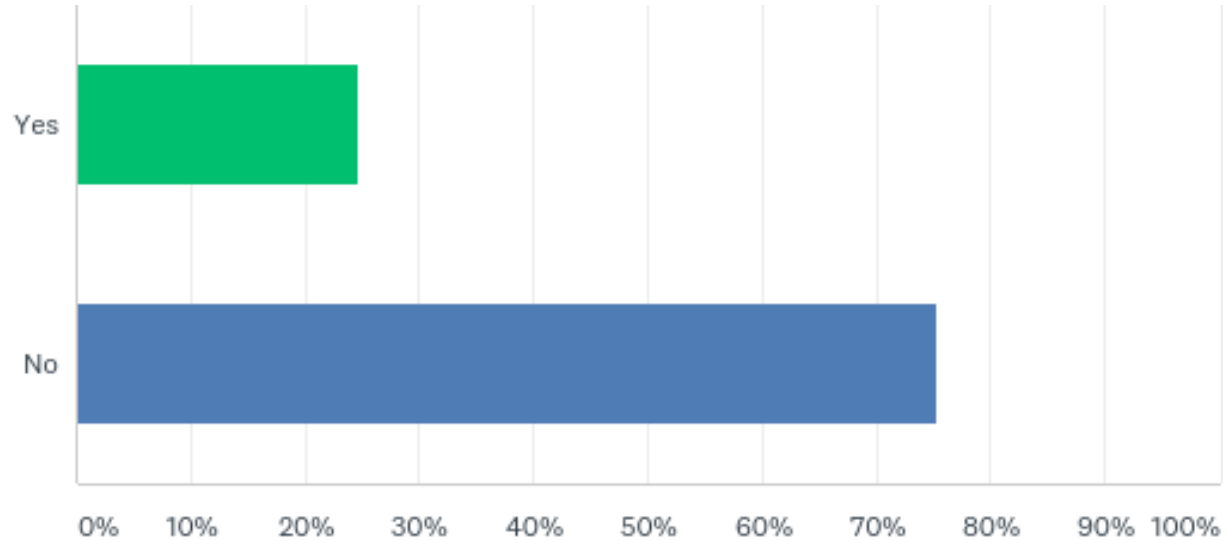

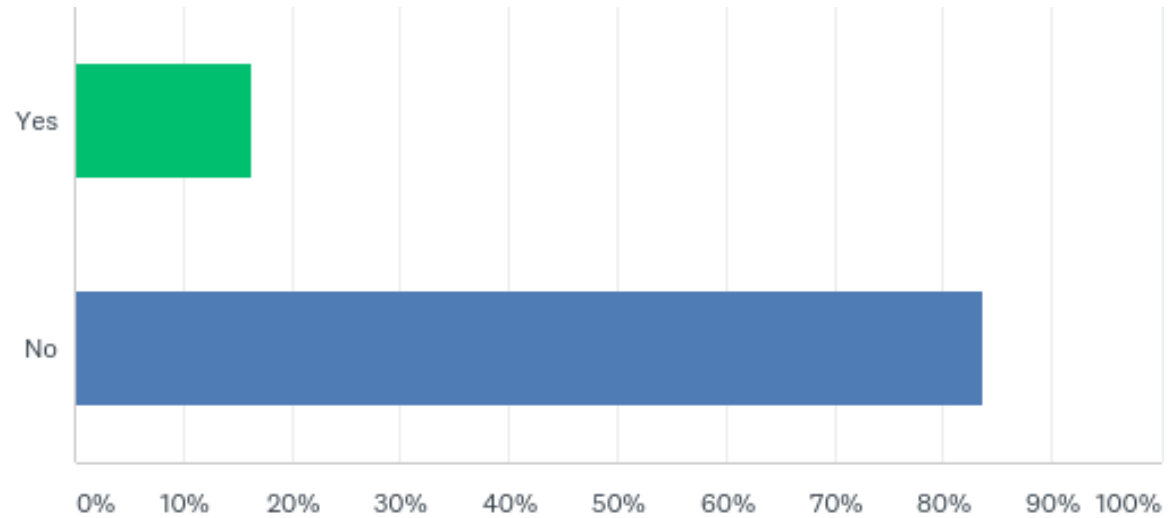

Q10: Under the new law dogs can not be crated overnight with the door shut, even if that is what happens at home. Do you agree with this law?

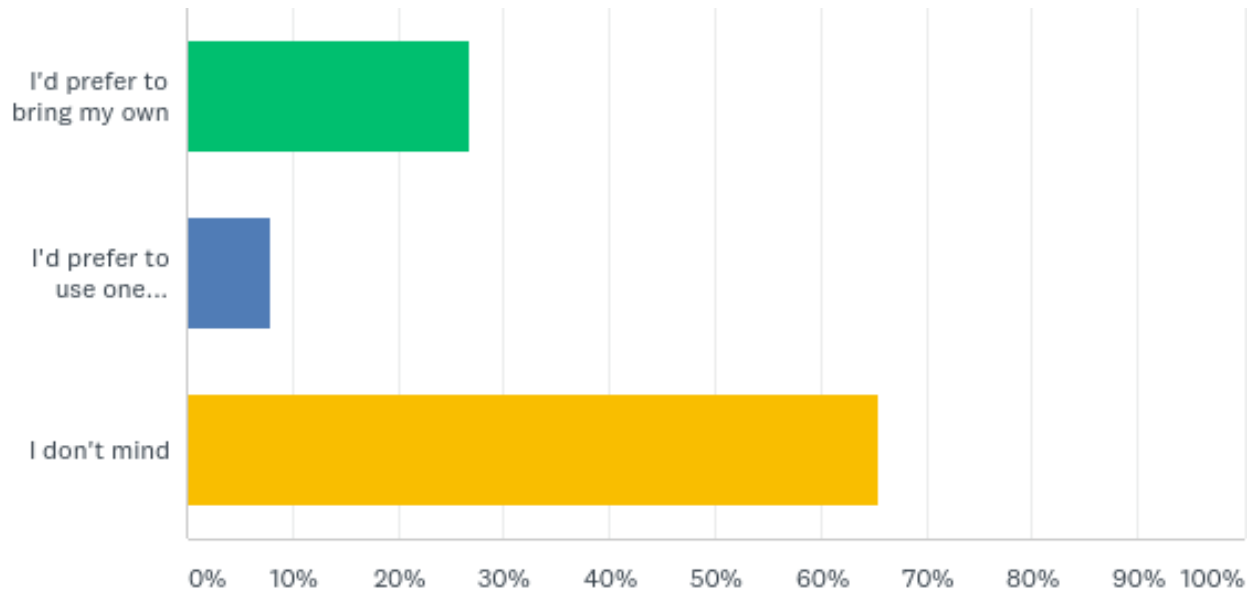

Q11: If your dog uses a crate would you want them to use one you provide or would you be happy to use one that your boarder provides?

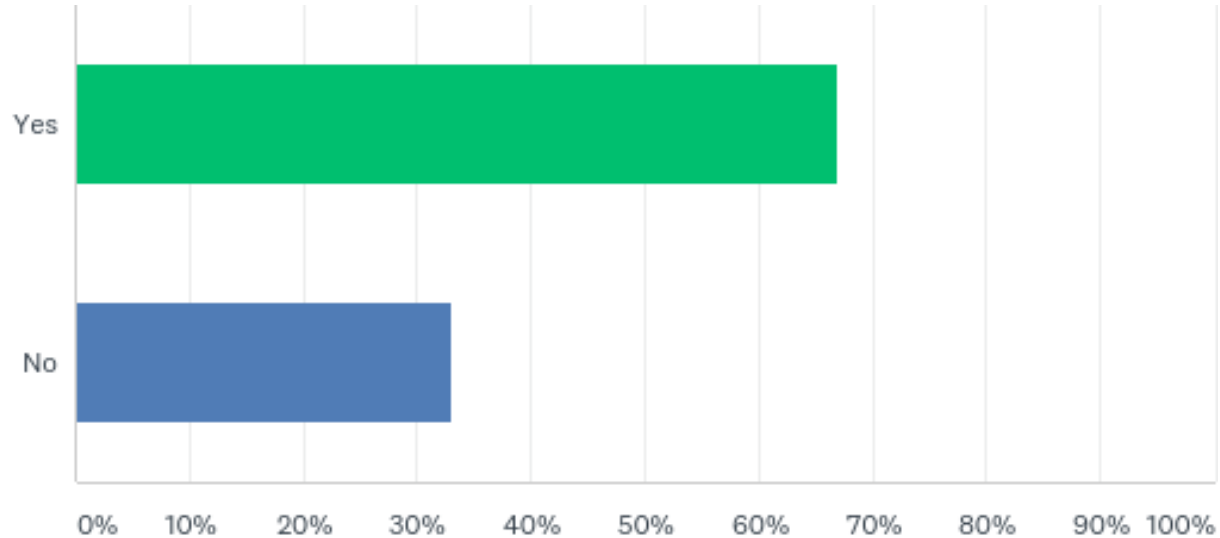

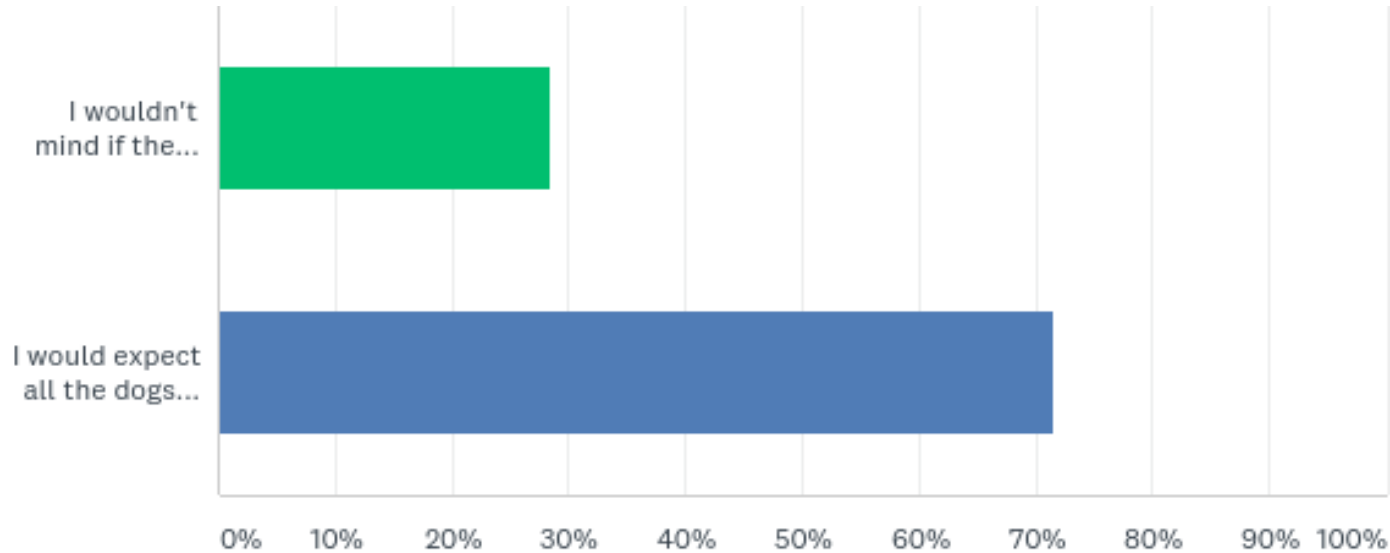
